Pursuant to the inherent powers of the District Courts and the County Courts-at-Law to provide for the speedy, efficient and inexpensive resolution of disputes, it is hereby ordered:

- 1. In every divorce action filed on or after March 1st, 2001 in Hays County, Texas involving children under the age of 18, all parties shall attend a court approved parenting class. See Exhibit "A" for a complete list of approved courses.
- 2. The course shall be attended within sixty (60) days of service of the original petition upon the original respondent.
- 3. No final hearing will be had without certificate of attendance attached to setting request.
- 4. Upon a party's failure to attend the seminar pursuant to this rule, the assigned judge may take appropriate action, including but not limited to actions for contempt.
- 5. For good cause shown, the assigned judge may waive the attendance requirement in individual cases.
- 6. The Hays County District Clerk shall furnish this Order upon all filed divorce cases.
